RULES & REGULATIONS

To be read in conjunction with Society Constitution, Rules & Regulations

1. All Colts must be handled by persons 17yrs & older.and must be double tied with a headstall & collar, with a lead rope attached to each separately whilst not being shown. Alternatively, they may be kept in the float or truck with the rear door closed and secured.
2. All foals must be a minimum of one month old. No foal to be clipped, plaited or bitted.
3. All foals must be lead behind the mare if not weaned. No free running foals allowed .
4. All animals competing under saddle in the youth ring must be 3yrs of age and older.
5. Any person deemed by the organising Committee to be excessively reprimanding or inappropriately treating an animal will be removed from the ring.
6. It is a condition of entry that all competitors and spectators whether actually engaged in or competing in an event or not, do so at their own risk, and no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society, its Officials, Committee or Members of any kind what so ever.
7. Australian Safety Approved Helmets must be worn by all competitors, regardless of the riders age, whilst mounted, at all times.
8. The Risk Management Officer has the power to instruct any persons not in compliance with the Risk Management Policy, to bring them in accordance with the Risk Management Policy as set out by this Society. Failure to adhere to this Policy will result in disqualification.
9. All protests must be in writing with the Show Secretary not later than one hour after Judging and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 which may be forfeited if the protest is considered by the Committee to be frivolous.
10. Any dispute will be determined by the Committee, whose decision will be final, and no correspondence on the decision will be considered.
11. No refunds will be given for animals that are scratched.
12. While every attempt is made for classes not to clash, there will be no refunds for entrants that miss their classes through no fault of the organisers.
13. No competitor may approach a judge for conversation. Any competitor wishing to converse with a judge must do so via the attending steward. If the judge wishes to converse, the steward must be present during any and all conversation.
14. All Stallions & Colts 2yrs & over must be shown in a bitted bridle.
15. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to competition for any animal or person at their discretion.

By signing the official Youngstock & Youth Member Entry Form, the entrant is acknowledging that they have read and understand these Rules and Regulations and are prepared to abide by them.
